

Haldex Streamlines the Manufacturing of Automatic Brake Adjusters

Haldex will continue to streamline the production of Automatic Brake Adjusters (ABA) by moving the production from the United States to Mexico. The process began in 2018 when machining of ABA's in the US was moved to India. In a final step, the assembly is now being moved from the plant in Blue Springs, Missouri USA to Monterrey, Nuevo León, Mexico. ABA's are Haldex's largest product line and they will now be manufactured in Brazil, China, Hungary, India and Mexico.

By co-locating the production of ABA's with the production in Mexico, Haldex's largest production facility globally, and thereby producing more products in one facility, economies of scale are achieved. The move will start immediately and will be completed during the fourth quarter of 2020. The transfer will be customer specific and will be a phased introduction.
